



## **SAMPLES OF WRITTEN TEXT FOR GAME INCIDENT REPORTS**

### **EXAMPLE #1**

#### CHECKING FROM BEHIND

This game was played at Armstrong Arena at the noted time and date.

At about 2:45 of the 2<sup>nd</sup> period in the Gloucester defending zone, at the corner boards, time keepers side of the ice, player no.28 of Orleans checked player no.3 of Gloucester from behind and into the boards. I was positioned at the half piston position on the opposite side of the ice with a clear view of the infraction. The impact of the check was minimal and there was no injury to the Gloucester player on the play. I immediately raised my arm for a delayed penalty and shortly thereafter when Orleans gained possession of the puck the play was stopped. I assessed a Checking From Behind Minor penalty and a Game Misconduct to player no.28 of Orleans, who left the ice without further incident. There was no question or concern expressed from the Orleans Coaching Staff.

### **EXAMPLE #2**

#### SLASHING WITH AN INJURY

This game was played at Orleans Sports Complex, Orleans rink at the noted time and date.

At about 8:22 of the 3<sup>rd</sup> period in the neutral zone, at the side boards, players bench side of the ice, player no.13 of Blackburn with both hands on his stick, slashed the left hand of player no.22 of Orleans (Randy BROWN). I was positioned on the opposite side of the ice, about three strides behind the play with a clear view of the infraction. I immediately raised my arm for a delayed penalty and shortly thereafter when Blackburn gained possession of the puck the play was stopped. Player no.22 of Orleans did leave the game under his own steam favouring his left hand. Due to the injury I assessed a Major penalty and a Game Misconduct for slashing to player no.13 of Blackburn, who left the ice without further incident. There was no question or concern expressed from the Blackburn Coaching Staff.

### **EXAMPLE #3**

#### **MINOR & MAJOR PENALTIES COMBINED**

This game was played at the Blackburn Arena at the noted time and date.

At about 4:38 of the 1<sup>st</sup> period in the Cumberland defending zone, at the corner boards, spectator side of the ice, player no.43 of Cumberland cross-checked player no.16 of Blackburn in the mid left arm. I was positioned on the opposite side of the ice, at the half piston position with a clear view of the infraction. Both of these players were expressing themselves verbally to one other after the initial cross-check by player no.43 of Cumberland. I immediately raised my arm for a delayed penalty, but before the play could be stopped, no.43 of Cumberland started a fight with player no.16 of Blackburn. Both players exchanged a few gloved blows with the linesman coming in quickly and separating the two, escorting them both to the respective penalty benches. There were no apparent injuries as a result to either player. Player no.43 of Cumberland was assessed a Minor penalty for Cross-Checking, a second Minor penalty for being the aggressor in the fight and a Major penalty and a Game Misconduct for Fighting (2+2+5+GM). Player no.16 of Blackburn was assessed a Major penalty and a Game Misconduct for Fighting (5+GM). Both players were separately escorted from the ice surface without further incident. The penalties were explained to both benches with no question or concern expressed from either of the Coaching Staff.
